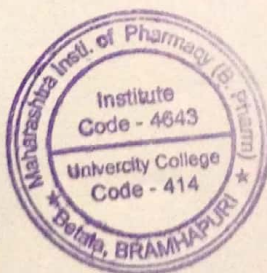




The institute has structured feedback mechanism to obtain feedback from internal and external stake holders through various programs.
